- Practise reading and writing words with the prefix 'un'.
- Practise your new handwriting style.

Number skills to practise

- Count in 5's and 10's.
- Write numbers up to 20 in the correct formation and in words.
- Create and solve some missing number problems. Make them as tricky as you'd like.
