


Overview of Learning for Spring (2) 2020

Enquiry question: Is trade with other places a good thing?

<p>Overview of Our Topic This topic builds on our Parliament & Power unit last half term and will immerse the children in British Values! Within this topic, we will explore who Britain currently trades with, in the EU and comparing how land and places in the UK make money. We will also look at global trade and the origins of food on our dinner plate.</p>		
<p>Vocabulary - These are words that we will be using in our learning. To help the children learn these new words, please have some fun using the words at home in different contexts: European immigration negotiation exportation importation globalisation distribution</p>		
<p>English This half term, we will be exploring a book called "Goodnight Mr Tom" by Michelle Magorian, where we will look at the effects of World War 2 and evacuation. We will also be reading other great texts this half term to stimulate a lot of writing opportunities.</p>	<p>Science This half term we will be learning about living things and their habitats, building on from our knowledge in Year 4. We will learn how to identify specific characteristics of species and classify animals. We will even create our own animal to survive in a given habitat!</p>	
<p>Maths We will continue to learn secure methods for the four rules. We will also be studying measure, shape, fractions and statistics (using graphs and charts to interrogate data)</p>	<p>Music This half term, the children will be continuing their learning of the Ukulele.</p>	
<p>Geography/History We will be exploring the geography of the UK and Europe. We will explore which places in Hampshire trade with Europe and investigate the impact of Brexit on Southampton Docks.</p>	<p>Art / DT This half term we will be putting our artistic skills to use again and creating our very own Dearsley Windows – more to be revealed later on!</p>	
<p>Computing In this topic we will be learning about computer networks, including how the internet works.</p>	<p>PE / Games Cricket and Gymnastics Our PE days this term are on a Monday and Tuesday. However, please ensure PE bags are in school all week in case this needs to change.</p>
