‘Are volcanoes or earthquakes more destructive?’

<p>Overview of Our Topic Throughout the summer term, Hedgehogs will be learning about a variety of volcanoes and earthquakes that have caused destruction to our world. We will consider why these disasters occur by exploring the geography of the earth as well concluding where most volcanoes are and the reasons why.</p>		
<p>Vocabulary. These are words that we will be using in our learning. <p>English This term we will be exploring traditional and twisted tales (including fairy tales). We will also be comparing how wolves are portrayed in real life comparing to traditional tales.</p>	<p>Science In science, we will start to look at plants and explore how they grow from seeds and bulbs. We will look at the parts of a flower and explore what plants need to grow successfully.</p>	
<p>Maths This half term, we will develop our fluency skills by practising written and mental methods to add, subtract, divide and multiply as well as practise telling the time regularly.</p>	<p>Music In music lessons we will explore different music from around the world, particularly the countries with different volcanoes.</p>	
<p>Geography We will develop our map skills when locating volcanoes in different countries as well as ask geographical questions about places and environments.</p>	<p>DT For DT this half term we will launch our topic with a series of sessions to design and create a paper-mache volcano. We will then add a mixture and watch them explode!</p>	
<p>Computing We will learn about using the internet safely and create posters to inform others. We will also use childnet and other websites to watch and discuss videos about staying safe online.</p>	<p>PE This half term, Hedgehogs will develop their skills to play tennis and create a dance linked to our countries famous sporting event ‘Wimbledon’.</p>	
<p>PSHE In PSHE lessons, Hedgehogs will continue to explore healthy relationships, how to manage emotions and valuing our differences through stories, circle time and games.</p>	<p>RE In RE, Hedgehogs will explore Ideas about God in Christianity and compare this to the beliefs in Hinduism.</p>	<p>MFL In French this half term, year 3s will learn about celebrations and continue to learn the names of the body parts through a variety of activities.</p>
