

We will also explore fiction texts such as playscripts.</p>	<p>Science In science, we will continue to explore animals, including humans. We will explore how different animals move and the importance of muscles and skeletons ready for our trip to Marwell Zoo.</p>	
<p>Maths This half term, we will continue to strengthen our reasoning and problem-solving skills in lessons as well as practise learning important number facts such as our number bonds and multiplication tables.</p>	<p>Music In music lessons we will focus on developing our tempo, rhythm and pitch when learning our songs for our spring production.</p>	
<p>History We will continue to explore the significant historical event, the first moon landing, and compare to more recent space explorations before answering our topic question.</p>	<p>Art In art lessons with Mrs Rymill, we will explore printing to create Easter themed pictures.</p>	
<p>Computing Year 3s will continue to develop their logical reasoning and Year 2s will explore coding by using the ‘Daisy the Dino’ app.</p>	<p>PE This half term, Hedgehogs will be exploring circuits and the importance of fitness as well as build on teamwork skills, throwing and catching by playing netball.</p>
