Number skills to practice

- You should still be securing all the times tables and their related division facts up to 12×12 . Identify and practise any you are not secure in, including $0.5 \times 4 =$ & $0.5 \times 0.4 =$
- Add, Subtract, Multiply and Divide fractions with the same and common denominators.
- Practise all 4 operations including applying to problems involving BODMAS.
