

You may have heard about the new General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"), that comes into effect 25th May 2018 concerning the storing and handling of people's data.

As someone who has volunteered to support Friends of Itchen Abbas, we wanted to update you on the data we store and how we use this data.

What data do we hold?

We only hold data that you have voluntarily provided to us, in the form of either email addresses and/or telephone numbers.

How is this data used?

This data is used by the Friends of Itchen Abbas committee members for the purpose of organising fundraising events. This data is also used by your identified year group representative to support Friends of Itchen Abbas fundraising activities. It may also be used by your class representative to organise social events for parents of that year group.

We do not pass your data onto to any other organisation and/or third party.

How do we store the data?

We are working to centralise the storage of this data so that it can be reviewed on an annual basis and ensure it is held securely.

How long do we hold data?

We hold data that you have voluntarily provided to us for the period of time that your child/children attend Itchen Abbas Primary school, unless you formally ask us to remove the data sooner.
